NATIONAL THEATRE AT HOME TO STREAM *THE OTHER PLACE*, A NEW PLAY INSPIRED BY *ANTIGONE* FEATURING EMMA D'ARCY

Theatre streaming platform **National Theatre at Home**, in association with **A Zeldin Company**, is set to release the world premiere of *The Other Place*, a new play inspired by Sophocles' classic story *Antigone*, directed and written by **Alexander Zeldin** (*The Confessions*, *Faith*, *Hope* and *Charity*) with music by **Yannis Philippakis** (*Foals*).

From March, audiences can watch the 'tremendous' (★★★★★ *Financial Times*) cast which includes **Emma D'Arcy** (*House of the Dragon*) as Annie, **Tobias Menzies** (*The Crown*) as Chris, **Alison Oliver** (*Saltburn*) as Issy, **Nina Sosanya** (*Screw*) as Erica, **Jerry Killick** (*The Confessions*) as Terry, and **Lee Braithwaite** (*Cowboys*) as Leni on National Theatre at Home.

Two sisters reunite on the anniversary of the death of their father. Their uncle has remodelled their family home, in an attempt at a fresh start. But one sister's sudden reappearance threatens to shatter this fragile idyll as she demands justice for the pain she carries.
